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

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

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

Details / Report of the Programme	<p>Demonstration of preparation of Envelop was guidance by the Sri Devaraj Y</p> <p>For the demonstration purpose we choose the 24 cm X 12 cm envelop.</p> <p>Procedure to Prepare Envelop:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Cut the drawing sheet so that the length and breadth is 24 + 2 cmseach.2. Fold the 24 + 2 cms breadth drawing sheet into equal parts so that both the parts measures 12 cms each and then paste it.3. Now the drawing sheet has the rectangular shape, then we need to mark half cms above and below of rectangular shaped drawing sheet. Then cut the marked one face of the drawing sheet and gum it.4. Now 24 cms length and 12 cms breadth sized envelop is ready to use. <p>After student teachers actively participated in the activity & asked to prepare a envelops to each groups.</p>

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

Details / Report of the Programme	<p>As a part of weekly SUPW activity, making flowers from sponze sheet demonstrations programme was organised on 14-05-2022. The demonstration was given by Dr.VaniNayaki D.C.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1.Cut the sponge sheet into rectangular long strips2. Use an average length of 30-35cm Sponze strips. And cut the width between 4-5cm.3. Fold the rectangular sponge strips lengthwise4.Start rolling from one end.5. You can add a twist if you like by making a 90 degree turn as you go along. It gives some added dimension but the Rose bud looks lovely even with simple rolling.6.As you roll you can shape your Sponge Rose Bud Flower. Keep a Tight hold on the flower base as you roll it.7.Take Floral wire and loop it loosely around the base of your Sponge rosebud. <p>Alternately if you like stitching you can secure your sponge rose using a needle</p>

and thread to secure the base.

8. You can cut off the Floral wire or keep it and use your rosebuds however you want.

Use it as a card embellishment

Make a bloom and put it in a flower vase.

For the demonstration purpose we choose the preparation of making Butterfly from colourpapers.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fold the paper in half, then open it and fold it in half the other way.• Fold the paper in half diagonally, open it, and fold on the other diagonal.• Bring the right and left creases together, creating a triangle.• Fold the 2 top corners into the centre.• Flip the triangle over and fold the bottom up, leaving a small tip showing.• Bend the top layer of the tip over the base.• Pull down the pieces from the bottom layer to create the lower wings.• Finally paper butterfly is ready for decorative purpose.

For the demonstration purpose we choose the preparation of making flowers from sponze sheets.</p> <p>Cut the sponze sheets into half sheet. Then cut the sheets into square shape of the paper, and fold the cut shapes into rectangle shapes of the whole sheets, then fold it whole flower shapes sheet and fold it like a rolling shape, and take both making buds shapes, then Staple it in edges of the flower, so finally ready, the sponze flowers are ready for decoration.</p>

Details / Report of the Programme	<p>The procedures of Preparation of making Jasmine flowers by using tissue papers is as follows...</p> <p>Dr.Devaraja Y Assistant Professor demonstrated the making of Jasmine flowers from tissue paper the procedure is as follows...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• At first take a full sheet of tissue paper and cut it into Small Square shaped pieces.• For making the flower take seven pieces of square shaped tissue paper.• Then roll the square shaped tissue into ball shape. In the same way we make three balls take another square shaped tissue, here balls put into tissue and roll.• Take another tissue piece make a stalk.• This process is continued to make many flower buds. Take green acrylic paint and mix with fevicol, By using finger colour the stalk and allow to dry for sometime. Now the Jasmine flowers is ready for use.

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

Details / Report of the Programme	<p>Bhagyashree H.D from third semester student – teacher demonstrated making best things from waste materials.</p> <p>The procedures of Preparation of making best things from using waste cups and used coconut shells are as follows... For the demonstration purpose we choose the preparation of making things from using waste cups and used coconut shells.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Take 2 Paper cups and covered by acrylic painting colour (Brown).• Along with it we need to colour the coconut shell with Brown Acrylic paint.• Let them dry for about 10-15 minutes.• Meanwhile we need to crop the paper and its size should be measured on the basis of cup mouth as well as coconut shell.• Now we have 3 cropped rounded shaped papers.• Take black acrylic colour and paint at centre of the paper by using brush and allow for dry.• Now take dried cups and join both 6 cups end together by using cello

(Transparent) straps.

- After that, take joined cups to insert the thread in Zig – Zag shape by using needle.
- After finishing thread work, now paste the cropped paper on the mouth of cups as well as coconut shell.
- Now take 15cm sized thread, and insert golden colour beads at both the end.
- Finally put knot & tie it to middle surface.
- Now Damaruga as well as Dolu is ready.

For the demonstration purpose we choose the preparation of making flowers from Tissue sheets.</p> <p>Cut the Tissue sheets into half sheet. Then again cut the sheets into square (2inches) shape of the paper, and firstly make tissue paper small bolls, next with that bolls using another cut sheets of tissue, role it then make it as jasmine flower shape. By using those jasmine flowers make the garland, so finally the Jasmine flowers garland is ready for using decoration.</p>

Take four different colour sheets, cut the straps by fixing each sheets exactly the length 10cm each and breadth 2cm each. After cutting the each straps in equal size then put it one by one, by alternative colours, then put stapler exactly at the middle of straps & also put the gum and fold it again – again exactly. After folding all these straps we got the round shape wall hanging. Lastly we tie the thread at the middle one strap in order to hang it easily.



For the demonstration purpose we choose the preparation of making decorative craft work of paper.</p> <p>Take a paper card board, make a big circle and cut it neatly. In other side take red color sheets, cut it as a small straps as 1cmx10cm and paste the both edge together, make at least to cover one big circle of paper card board.</p> <p>Next take yellow colour sheet to make inner portion of craft, Now take 3 yellow sheets & roll it one edge to another, make it like a straw shaped. Lastly take all rolled yellow sheets paste it from back side paper card board along with it add flowers to it, Now you have beautiful wall hangings.</p>
