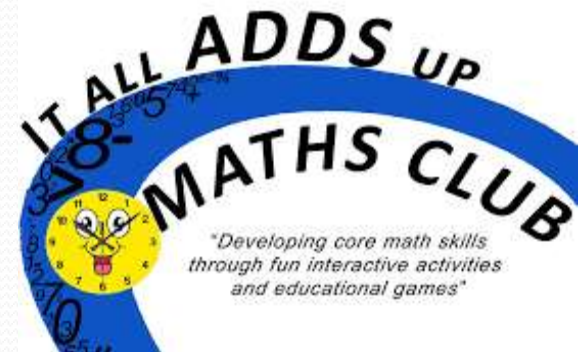
Importance of Mathematics club:

The following office – bearers are essential for the successful working of the mathematics club.





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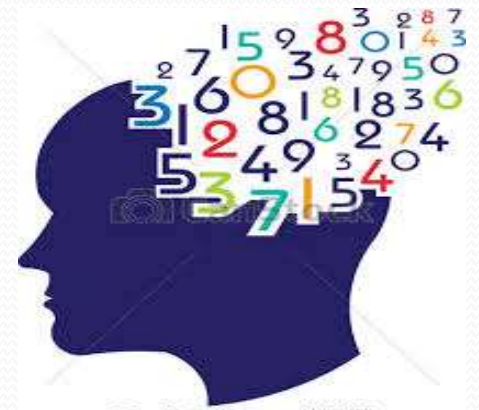
The following office – bearers are essential for the successful working of the mathematics club.

- One or two class representative from each class.
